

Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

1. Golf Cart Guidelines: In an effort to promote safety and security for our residents, the Board of Directors inaugurated the following guidelines:
 - a. Golf carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark.
 - b. Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learner permit.
 - c. Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
 - d. Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.
 - e. Liability Insurance is available for Golf Carts and the Board of Directors highly recommends you have this coverage on your personal golf cart.
2. Golf Cart/Community Property: Please note that golf carts should not be driven on the beaches, ball field, and clubhouse lawn

Won't You Be My Neighbor...




Below is an email we received from a family member of a former early homeowner. I edited some of the content, and it includes a poem written by his mother. If anyone has any recollection of the Waterman/Scott family, let me know and I will relay the information to Bob.

My parents, William and Ann (Peggy) Scott (nee' Waterman), had a house, probably purchased by her father, at Candlewood Knolls, as indicated by this poem. Our mother died on January 31, 1948. During her last years, she wrote several poems about her life, some of which were published. Our guess is that she wrote this poem around 1946.

I read your 75th anniversary column and noted that one of the founders was a real estate person in Mount Vernon. Our maternal grandparents lived in Mount Vernon and our grandfather was in real estate as well as serving as an elected official in the city. My guess is that he knew Candlewood Knolls co-founder Clarence Martens and learned about it from him.

Book Review



Homecoming: A Novel by **Kate Morton** is a long book but worth the time to read. A spellbinding mystery, it begins with a devastating crime with effects that ripple across two continents and several generations. The book has many characters whose lives crossed paths and are intertwined, making the crime even more unbelievable. It has you guessing until the very end.

At the end of a scorching hot Christmas Eve day in South Australia, a local man makes a terrible discovery on the grounds of a grand house. Police are called, and the small town becomes embroiled in a baffling murder investigation. Many years later and thousands of miles away, there is a journalist in search of a story. A phone call out of nowhere summons Jess back to Australia, where her beloved grandmother Nora, who raised Jess when her mother could not, has suffered a fall and is seriously ill in the hospital. At Nora's house, Jess discovers a true crime book chronicling a long-buried police case: the Turner Family Tragedy of 1959. It is only when she skims through its pages that she finds a shocking connection between her own family and this notorious event—a mystery that has never been satisfactorily resolved.

A story that spans generations, *Homecoming* asks what we would do for those we love, how we protect the lies we tell, and what it means to come home.
