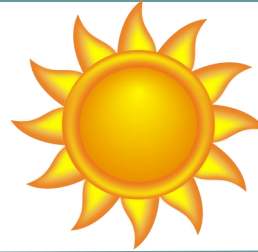

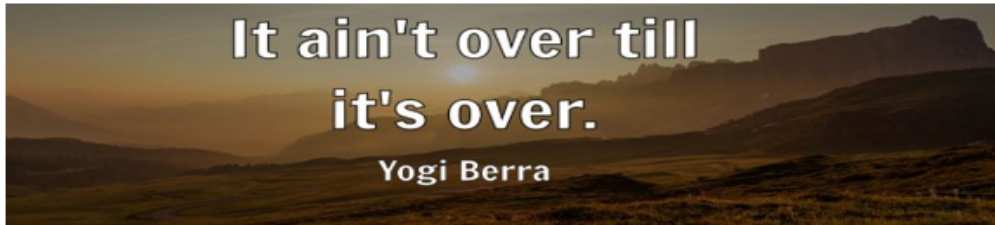

Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

1. Golf Cart Guidelines: In an effort to promote safety and security for our residents, the Board of Directors inaugurated the following guidelines:
 - a. Golf carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark.
 - b. Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learner permit.
 - c. Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
 - d. Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.
 - e. Liability Insurance is available for Golf Carts and the Board of Directors highly recommends you have this coverage on your personal golf cart.
2. Golf Cart/Community Property: Please note that golf carts should not be driven on the beaches, ball field, and clubhouse lawn

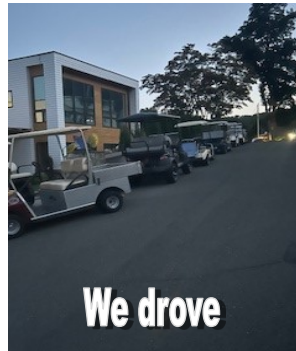

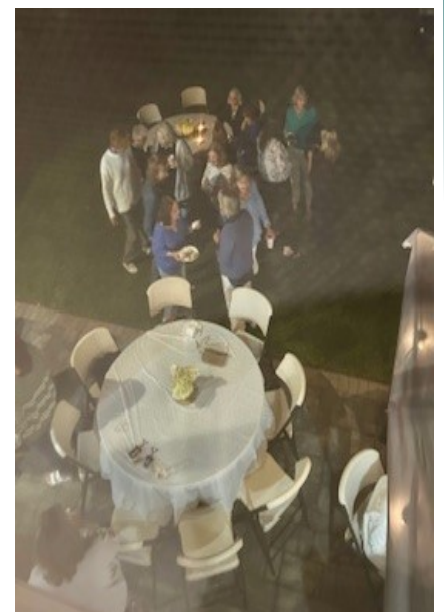

The Clegg Family



Dave Clegg grew up in LaGrange NY, a suburb of Poughkeepsie, with one older brother Richard. His parents, Ann & George, bought a home on Woods Road in 1957 and sold in 2011. Dave enjoyed many summers here in the Knolls. When he was a teenager his CK group of friends would paint houses to make money for boat gas as they were all avid skiers! Like most of us, Dave also spent many summers in the Children's Program learning to swim and blowing bubbles under the direction of Marie Minervini. It is here in the Knolls in 1977 that Dave also met his wife, Maureen Keenan who grew up in

Ardasley NY and had a family summer home in CK. He was in college, and she was starting senior year of HS. The relationship lasted long distance as Maureen attended Villanova, graduating with a civil engineering degree. They married in 1982.

Dave attended Cornell University for his bachelor's and master's degrees and then went on to Michigan State University for his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine. Maureen & Dave settled in Liverpool NY, a northern suburb of Syracuse, where Dave bought a small veterinary practice and turned it into a seven day a week six Doctor practice. They raised their family of Megan, who is a product designer for Affinity and resides in Brooklyn with her longtime partner Andrew; Bryan who is a VP at AECOM Tishman who resides in Wilton with his wife Kelsey and two beautiful boys, Silas & Cameron; and Devin who is finishing up his surgical residency at the Univ of TN Medical Center and moving onto his fellowship at Harvard in Boston in July 2025 with his wife Emily. The family loved all that Upstate NY had to offer including snow skiing and lacrosse. Dave coached boys' lacrosse for years until they started travel teams which turned into college lacrosse. When the two oldest graduated from college and moved to Brooklyn & NYC it was time to start looking for a summer home closer to them. It just so happened that 5 Lakeshore So. became available, and they purchased it in August 2014. If you had asked either one of them if they were going to retire in CK the answer would have been "no way." Then their youngest moved to TN, the other two were still in NYC, Covid hit, and here they are in the Knolls. Dave retired in 2019 and they moved to CK full time in July 2019. Maureen retired as Sr VP of an engineering firm at the start of 2022.

Dave & Maureen had both been very active in the kids' schools, sports, and community, so it was destined that they would be active here at our beloved CK and in the Town of New Fairfield. Dave joined the CK Board in 2018 and started his presidency in Jan 2023. He has loved getting to know everyone and diving into issues for resolution. 
