### Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
  - Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
  - Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
  - Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

## WATERING YOUR GARDEN

During this hot weather, make sure to pay attention to your plants watering needs. Overwatering is the most common cause of harm to young plants. If you are not sure about how often to water your plants, simply feel the soil to see if it is moist or if it feels close to drying out. If the plant leaves are curling and turning light brown, then they are dry and need more water. If the leaves start to droop or wilt and look like they are too heavy or they are turning dark brown or black, then your plant is getting too much water.

In the summer, the best time to water plants is in the early morning or early evening. Be sure to slowly increase the amount of water you give the plant and don't try to correct “under” watering by “over” watering. It's best to give your plants a slow deep watering every few days by holding the hose to your plant base and counting 20 seconds. This will allow the water to soak deeper into the soil which will result in a more rooted plant that holds the moisture. Adding a 3 inch layer of mulch around the soil and base of your plants can be extremely beneficial since mulch also helps keep plants cool and allows them to slowly warm up.
