Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

Stockholder #9 - The Caterson Family – 5 Generations

In February 1938, our grandparents, Hamilton (Ham) and Viola Caterson, purchased the house on Meadoway (#9), and became one of the initial Candlewood Knolls stockholders, with Stock Certificate #9. Over the years, Ham and Viola fixed up the house and winterized it for yearround use. At the time, they probably had no idea that 86 years and five generations later, Candlewood Knolls and that little house would be as cherished now as it was back then.

While our grandparents and our father, Willis, spent winters in the Bronx, they eagerly looked forward to summers at the lake. Willis participated in the Childrens' Program, enjoyed softball games against the Isle, water skiing, and swimming. He especially excelled at swimming and held several swim records at the Knolls and around the Lake. As Willis aged-out of the Childrens' Program, he then became a counselor for several summers and won the Larry Leibler Award in 1954. He also served as President of the Knolls from



1986-1989. Willis loved the Family Picnic, South Beach, and most importantly the Sunday Sunfish Sailboat Races--of which the goal was to always beat Vinny Blaine.

Moving forward, Willis married Peggy, and she quickly became part of the Knolls community. Their daughters Kim, Kris, and Suzie have many very fond memories of the Knolls and the Childrens' Program. Counselor hunts, hikes to Big Rock, never-ending softball games, swim meets, and going to the Farmhouse for penny candy and pinball. In the evenings, they enjoyed movie nights at the Clubhouse, hanging out with friends at the playground or ballfield, knowing it was time to go home when the streetlight at the Clubhouse turned on. A fun fact that few people

may know is that in 1976, Kim also won the Leibler Award, which as far as we know, makes the first and only father-daughter duo to win the award. Most importantly, though, the Caterson sisters cherish the life-long friends they have made at the Knolls.

Currently, Kim (Maneval), Kris (Hardiman), and Suzie (Shanahan) and their 7 adult children and Kim's 4 grandchildren have the great privilege of enjoying the Knolls and all it has to offer. While we can tell friends and co-workers about the Knolls, no one can truly understand the camaraderie, beauty, and joy of this close-knit community we call Candlewood Knolls. While the Knolls has grown and changed with the times, the spirit of our little community remains 95 years strong.


