Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - CKWA Water Tank Replacement

The project to replace the CKWA storage tanks has begun with the new tanks being delivered this week. While this project is ongoing we will have a diminished storage capacity for our water supply. Our calculations show we should not have an issue however we are asking all residents using the CK water system to reduce the use of water to necessary activities only- no watering of lawns, hand watering of plants/flowers, no washing of cars. Make sure all hoses are completely shut off and toilets are not leaking to conserve water waste. Water conservation is very important especially on weekends when demand is usually higher. **Please begin this process on Monday, August 9th** -- it may be a 2 week process, we will inform when the water restriction is lifted. Sorry for any inconvenience.

Boat Trailer Access at Tank Site.

With the CKWA tank replacement commencing currently there will be limited access to the trailer stored there. The gate and lock have been removed. There will be equipment placed at the site entrance during the evenings so no one will have access to trailers and they will be secured. If you need access to your trailer over the next 2 weeks **please contact the Maintenance office(203-746-2048)** to arrange access safely. Sorry for any inconvenience.




DISNEY CHARACTER BREAKFAST




